

## **Instructions for importing feline and canine samples into the United States**

- 1.) Print Statement About Sample (second page) on facility's letterhead. The letterhead must include the facility's physical address.
- 2.) Fill out Statement About Sample.
- 3.) Fold the Statement About Sample and place it in an envelope.
- 4.) Write the words "Statement About Sample" on the outside of the envelope and tape the envelope to the outside of your package with the words "Statement About Sample" facing out.
